Pre-surgical instructions

1 - 2 weeks before your procedure

Someone from our office will call you to confirm the procedure date

If medical or cardiac clearances have been ordered, please make your appointments.

Complete any blood work that has been ordered

You can do this at the Silver Cross
 Hospital Outpatient Testing
 Center or your Primary Care
 Doctor's office

5 – 7 days before your procedure

Stop taking any blood thinning medications such as Aspirin, Aleve, Advil, Ibuprofen, Motrin, Fish Oil

If you are taking a prescription blood thinner such as Eliquis, Coumadin, Warfarin, Xarelto, you will need to discuss with your cardiologist for instructions on how and when to hold your medication before your procedure

1 – 2 days before your procedure

The surgical department at the hospital will call you to confirm your exact arrival time and confirm instructions

The night before your procedure

Shower/wash your surgical location with Hibiclens soap/antiseptic skin cleanser. Use a clean towel and washcloth. Rinse well to ensure all soap has been removed. Wear clean clothes. Do not apply lotions, powers, hairspray, or makeup.

Do not shave the surgical site

Do not eat or drink anything after midnight

You may have a small sip of water up to 3 hours before your procedure

The day of your procedure

If you are taking blood pressure medications, do not take these the morning of the procedure.

You will need a ride home from the hospital. You are not allowed to use Uber, Lyft, or other ride share services

Follow all post surgical instructions you received from your doctor
